



RULES OF THE “liLETRAd 2017” LITERARY CONTEST

The liLETRAd INTERNACIONAL association convenes the literary contest “liLETRAd 2017”.

liLETRAd INTERNACIONAL (Reg. Paseo de la Castellana, 144, Madrid) aims at promoting both LANGUAGES and LITERATURE, and LANGUAGE and TRANSLATION by means of cultural exchanges. We are organizing our next INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE 2017.

Novelties in this edition are the inclusion of new panels and a LITERARY CONTEST, whose awards ceremony will be held during the same event, celebrated on the 5, 6 and 7th of July 2017 in the city of Seville (Spain).

Anyone interested in participating in our contest may submit an unpublished work in the genres of narrative, poetry or theater and script or short story. The single winner of the contest will be awarded with the edition of his or her work in a reputed publishing house, plus an award plaque and certificate; the only condition is that incoming works must focus on the conference line of argument: “Building bridges from East to West”.

Works may be submitted in any of the following languages, including translation from original works as well: Spanish, English, German, French, Italian and Portuguese, Chinese, Arabic and Russian.

The evaluation committee will be composed of academics and professors or recognized professionals, they will have the right to comment but not to vote; The liLETRAd INTERNACIONAL Association will vote and select the 5 finalists. The name of the winner will be communicated during the event.

The format of the works needs to be adjusted to Times New Roman 12, with spacing between 1.5 and 2 points; their length should not exceed from 100 pages in narrative, 70 pages in poetry, theatre or script, and 12 pages in short stories.

Works must be submitted electronically in two Word files (one should include your name and the other a pseudonym) as well as in PDF file, including name, contact information and title of your work, before 15th of May 2016 to liLETRAd INTERNACIONAL, whose email account is the following: aliletrad@gmail.com
